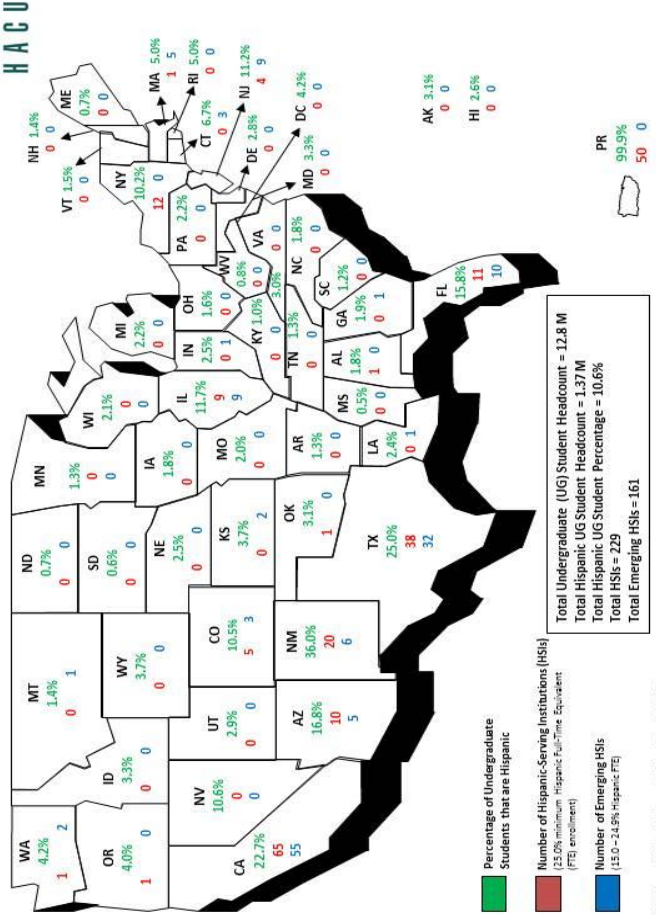

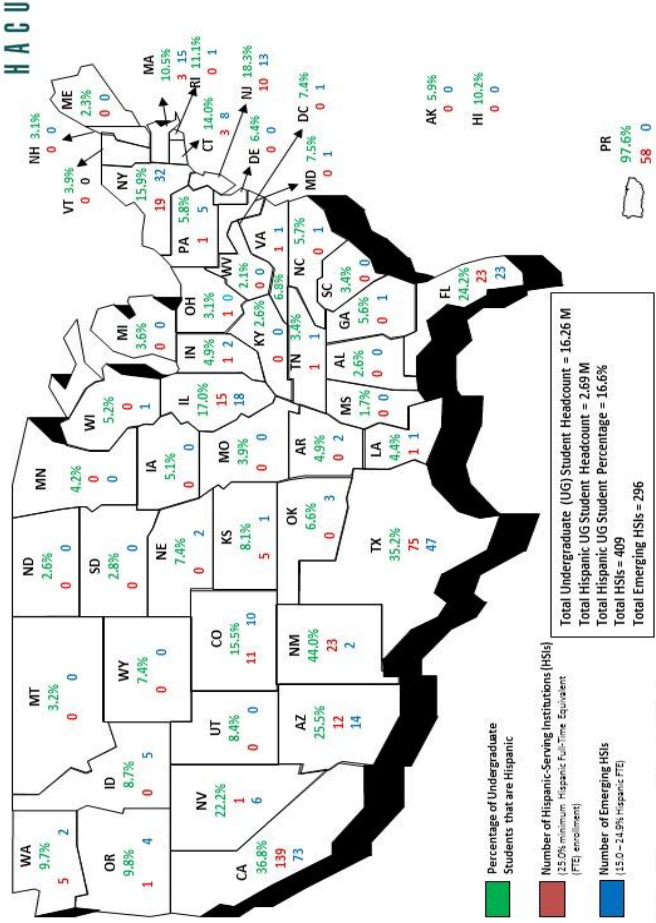
2000-01 Fall Enrollment Snapshot Hispanic Undergraduate Students
