

Fall 2019 Bi-Annual Data Update

Program Highlights

Dual Degree Program is proud to share that as of Sept 30, 2019, there are **448** total DDP students in the pipeline at our partner community colleges. In addition, over **89%** of the DDP students who have completed their associate degrees and enrolled at GSU have graduated, transferred, or are still enrolled and pursuing their degrees!

- In the 2018-2019 academic year, DDP enrolled 353 new students at our partnering community colleges.
- DDP students currently enrolled at GSU have an average GPA of 3.48; GSU Promise Scholarship recipients have an average GPA of 3.53, and DDP Honors Scholarship recipients continue to have an average GPA of 3.89.
- DDP-GSU graduates complete their bachelor's degrees in an average of 4.1 semesters.
