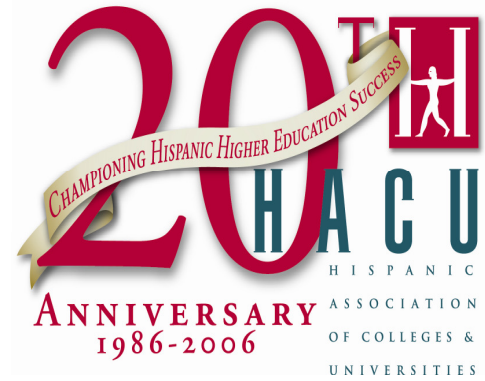

HACU Urges Opposition to Representative Gray's HB 2068 and HB 2069

HACU urges the leadership of all its Arizona members to **immediately** contact AZ State Representative Laura Knaperek, Chair of House Universities, Community Colleges and Technology Committee, to stop HB 2068 and HB 2069 from passing out of committee. House Bill 2068 and House Bill 2069 would prohibit undocumented students from accessing financial aid or paying in-state tuition at AZ colleges and universities.

Background Info: HB 2068 and HB 2069 were introduced on January 9, 2006. **This bill may come up for a hearing in UCCT as soon as January 17, 2006.** See attachments for a copy of the bill and a sample letter.
