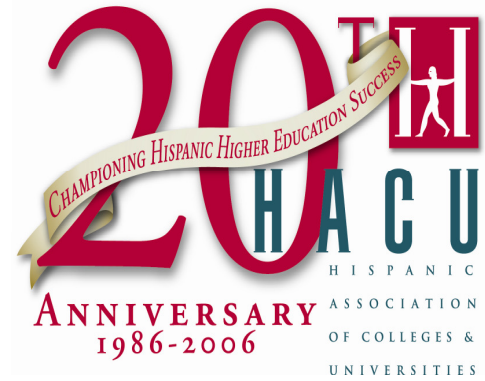

HACU Urges Opposition to Senate Concurrent Resolution (SCR) 1031

HACU urges the leadership of all its Arizona members to **immediately** contact their Member in the Arizona House of Representatives to oppose SCR 1031. Among other things, SCR 1031 would prohibit undocumented students from accessing financial aid or paying in-state tuition at AZ colleges and universities; would deny adult education to undocumented immigrants; and would prevent the children of undocumented immigrants from accessing the family literacy program or child care assistance.

Background information: SCR 1031 could come up for a vote on the Floor of the House of Representatives at any time. **If this bill is passed, it will go directly to the voters – without the possibility of a gubernatorial veto.** See attachments for a copy of the bill and a sample letter.
