## **RESOLUTION**

- Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that a National Hispanic-Serving Institutions Week should be established.
- Whereas Hispanic-Serving Institutions play an important role in educating many underprivileged students and helping them attain their full potential through higher education;
- Whereas there are currently about 268 Hispanic-Serving Institutions in the United States;
- Whereas Hispanic-Serving Institutions educate over 50 percent of all Hispanics who attend colleges and universities throughout the Nation;

Whereas Hispanic-Serving Institutions are actively involved in stabilizing and improving their communities; Whereas celebrating the vast contributions of Hispanic-Serving Institutions contributes to the strength and culture of our Nation; Whereas the achievements and goals of Hispanic-Serving Institutions are deserving of national recognition; and Whereas the week of September 20th would be an appropriate week for such recognition: Now, therefore, be it 1 Resolved, That the House of Representatives— 2 (1) recognizes the achievements and goals of 3 Hispanic-Serving Institutions across the country; 4 (2) supports the designation of an appropriate 5 week as "National Hispanic-Serving Institutions Week"; 6 7 (3) requests the President to issue a proclama-8 tion designating such week; and 9 (4) calling on the people of the United States 10 and interested groups to observe such week with ap-11 propriate ceremonies, activities, and programs to 12 demonstrate support for Hispanic-Serving Institu-
