



VOCES NUEVAS PROGRAM

Voces Nuevas is a student advocacy and leadership program designed to elevate, uplift, and empower undergraduate students' voices and experiences.

Through the program, students will be equipped with advocacy and leadership skills to enable them to effectively voice their concerns and to devise strategic actions that will promote the development of innovative socially conscious solutions at the local, state, and national levels. Collectively, this program aims to empower students to enact change in their communities to improve Hispanic educational and economic outcomes.

Through a sponsorship made possible by Capital One, ten students (five from California and five from Texas) will be selected to participate in the program. Students will receive a \$2,000 participation stipend and attend HACU's National Capitol Forum in 2024.

Eligibility: Sophomores, juniors, or seniors enrolled in an undergraduate degree program and those who attend a HACU-member institution in Texas or California. Ideal candidates are undergraduate students who are interested in public policy issues, eager to engage with other students, and committed to issues related to Hispanic success.
