

The Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) and the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) are partnering together to select up to 30 college freshmen and sophomores to travel to Washington D.C. from June 03, 2024 to June 07, 2024 and participate in a four-day career exploration event. During the event, students will visit the CIA and meet with CIA professionals to learn about the culture, expectations, and opportunities available when pursuing a career with the CIA. The event will consist of informational workshops and networking activities. After the event, students will be encouraged to apply for CIA internships.

Eligibility Criteria:

- U.S. citizens
- Currently enrolled as an undergraduate <u>Freshman</u> or <u>Sophomore</u> at a <u>HACU-Member Institution</u>
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- All Majors are encouraged to apply
- Carry at least 12 credit hours
- · Have excellent writing and briefing skills.
- Have an interest in serving as a civilian in the Intelligence Community
- Able to meet CIA suitability requirements and background investigation (character and conduct)
