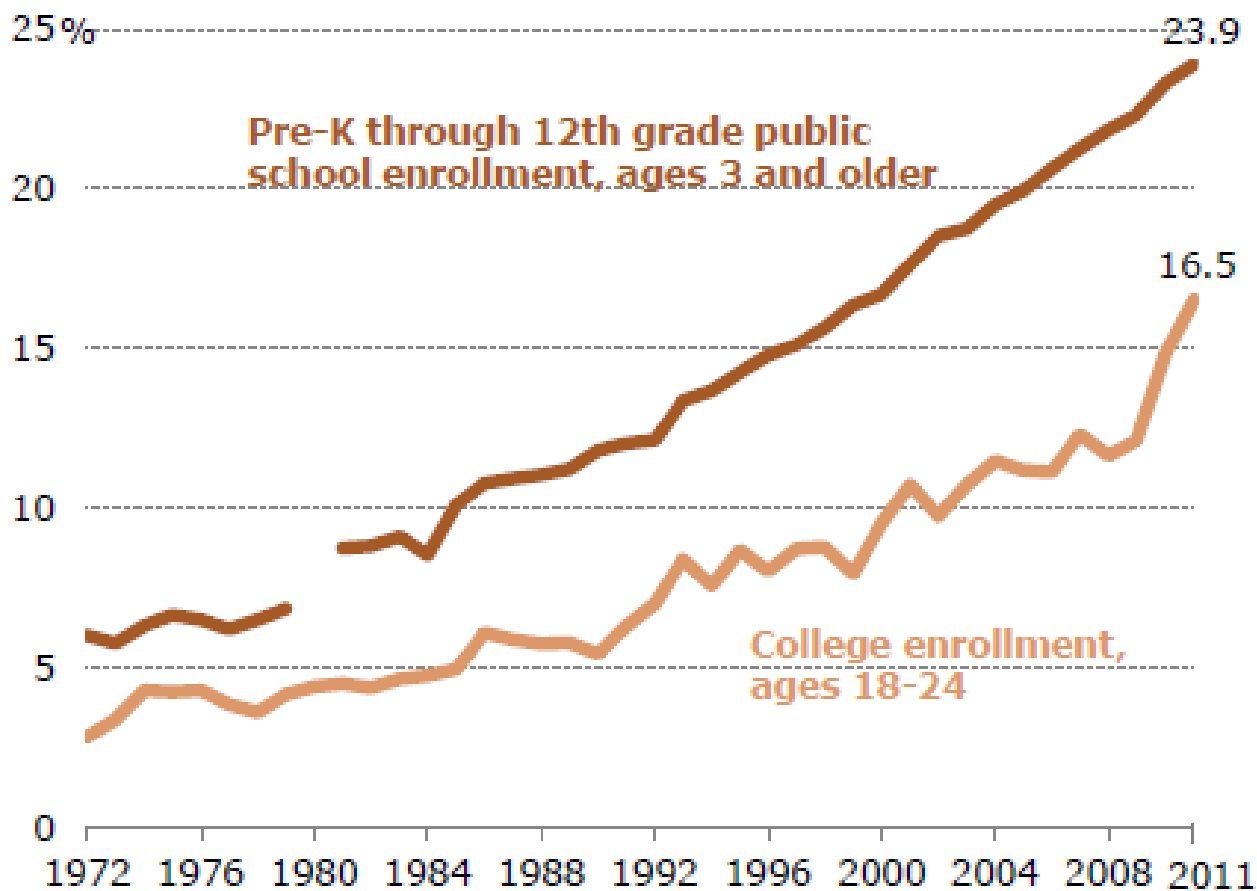

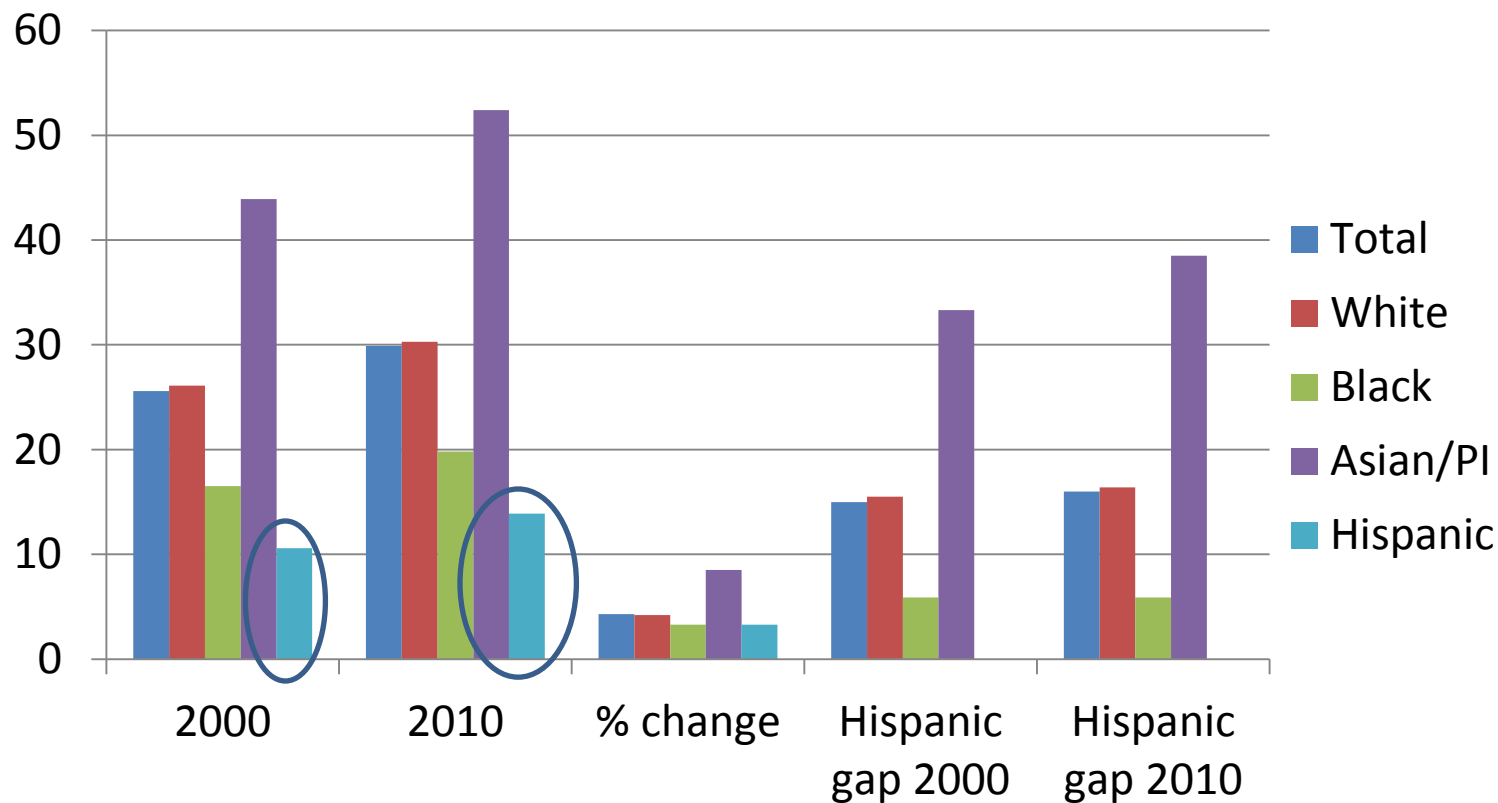

Percent College Graduate or More



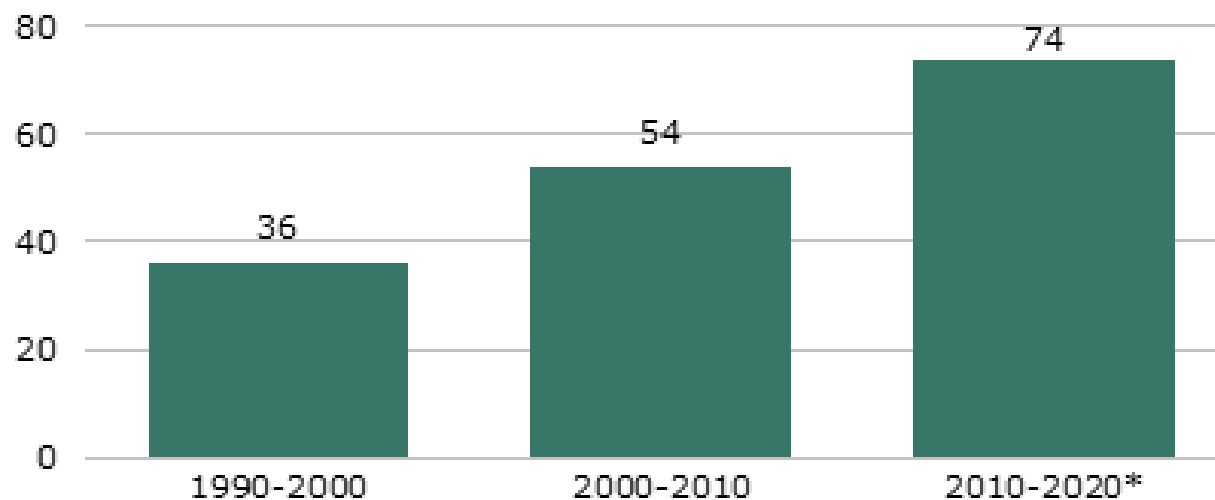

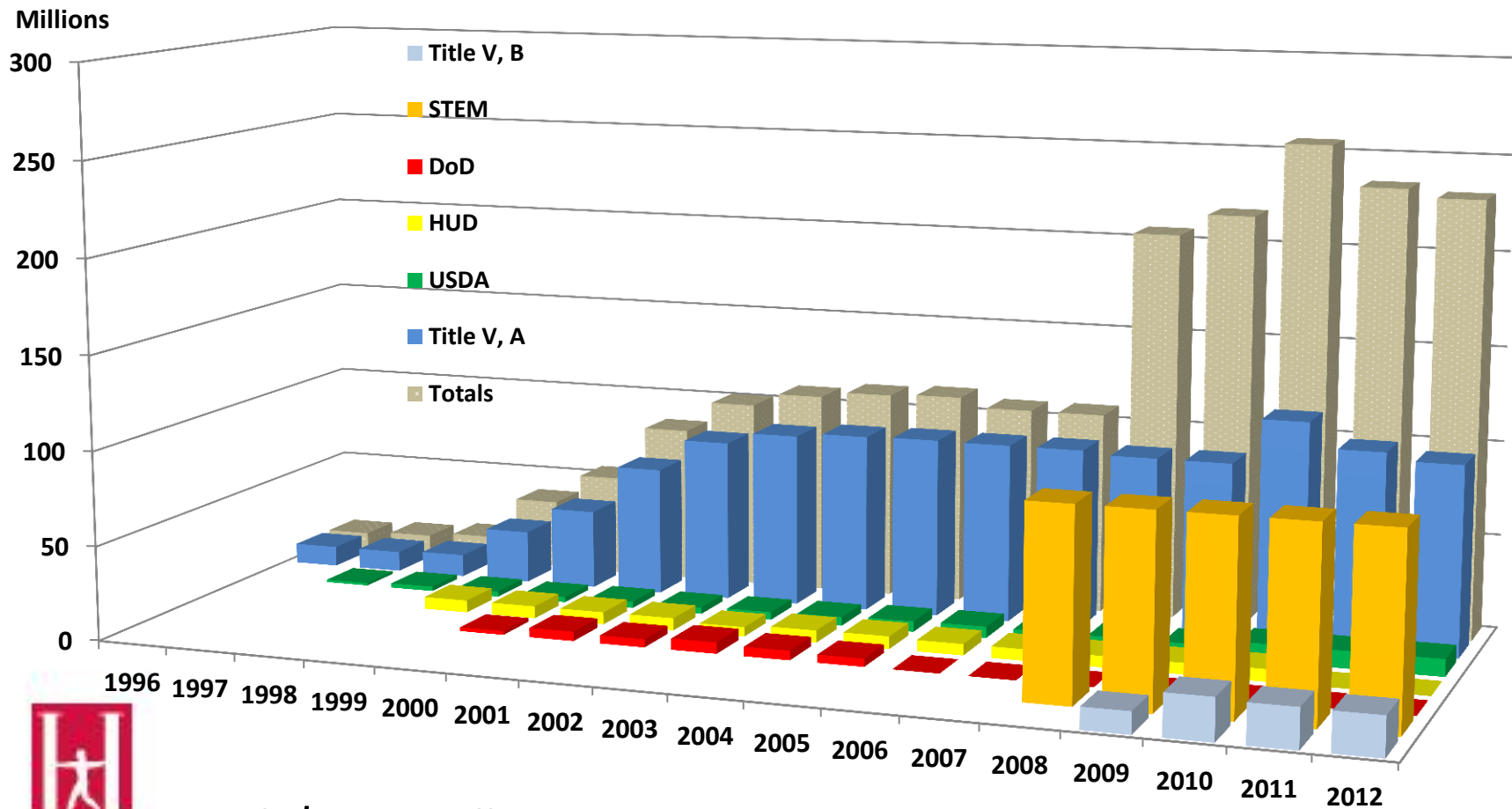

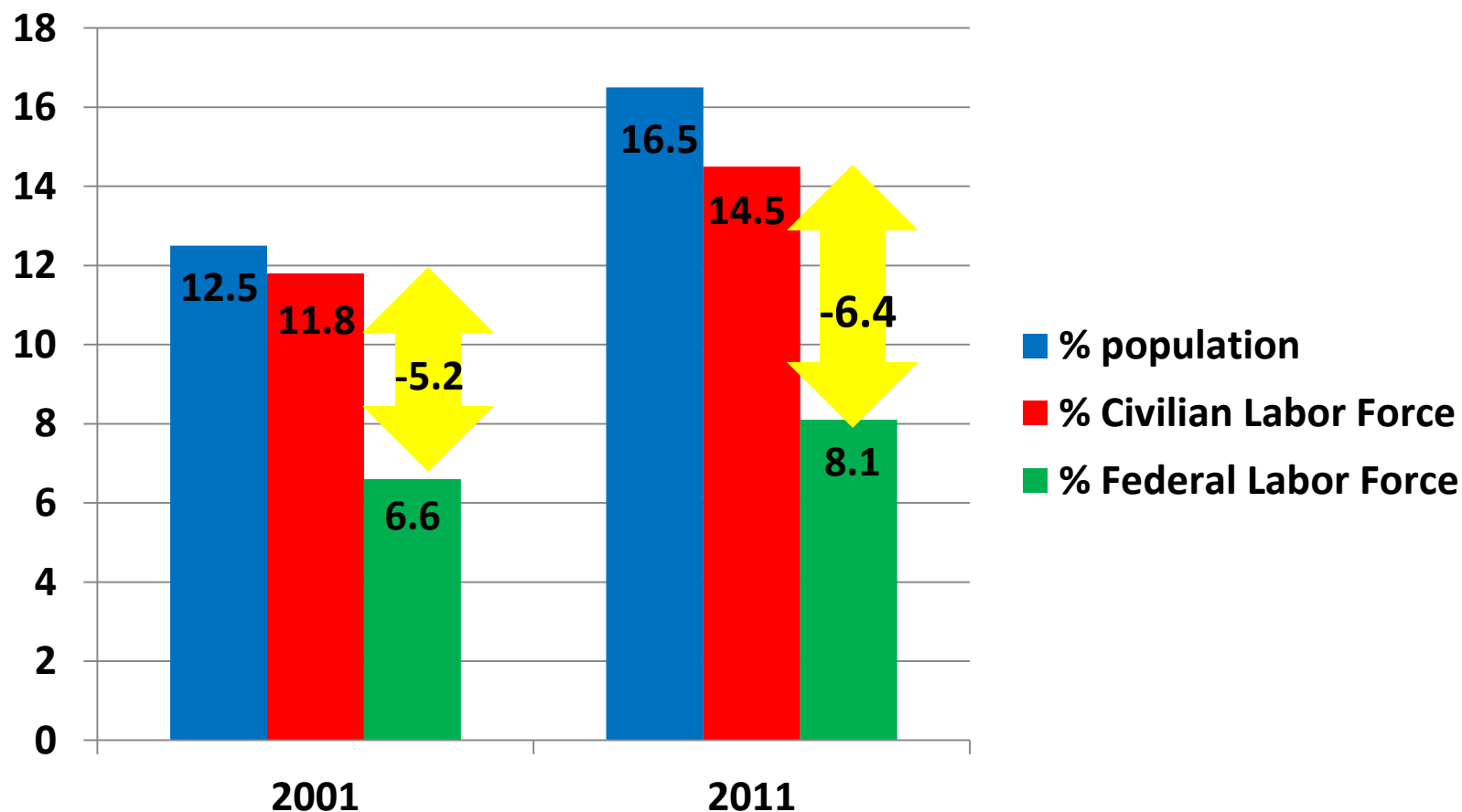
HSI Appropriations 1995-2012



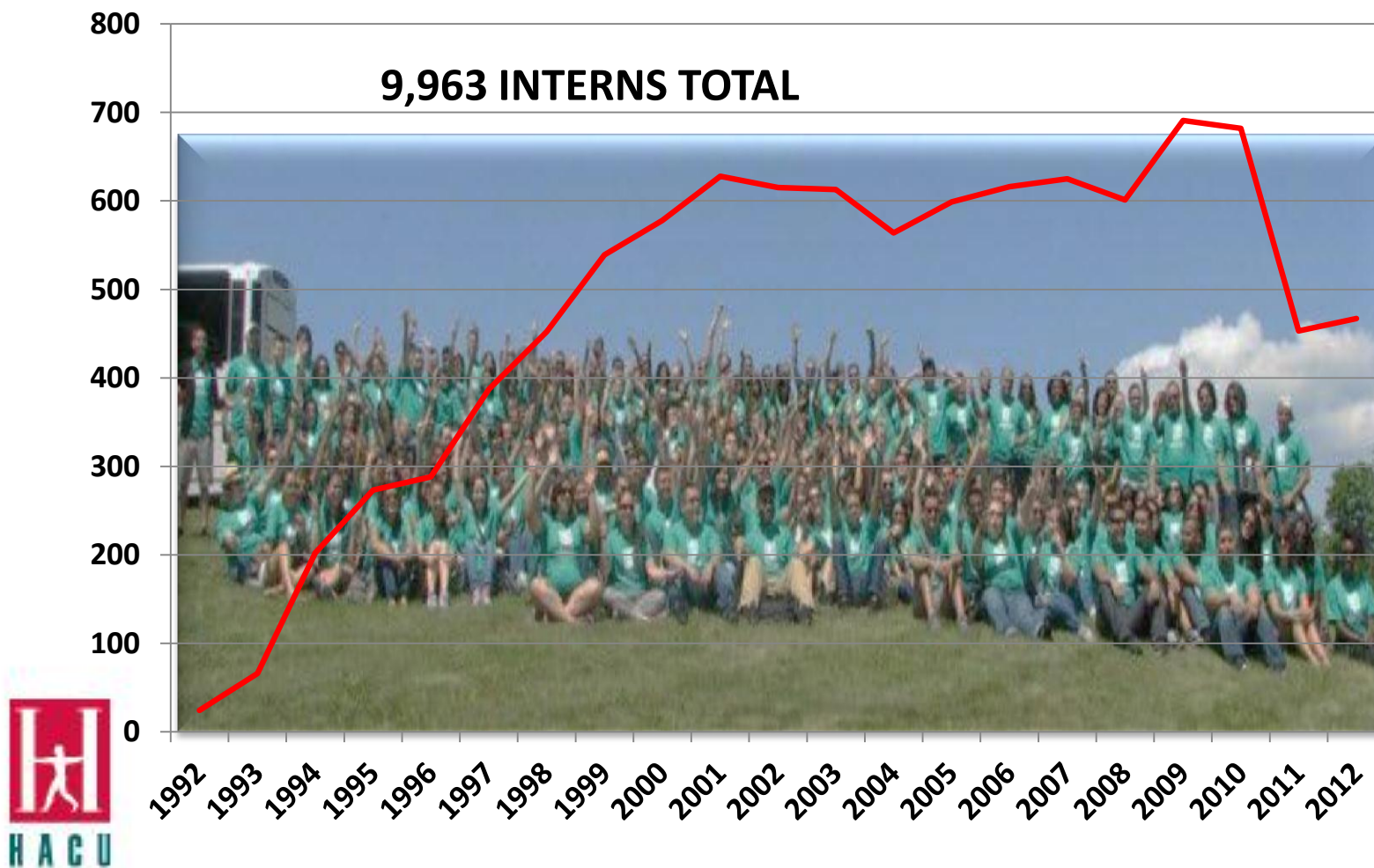

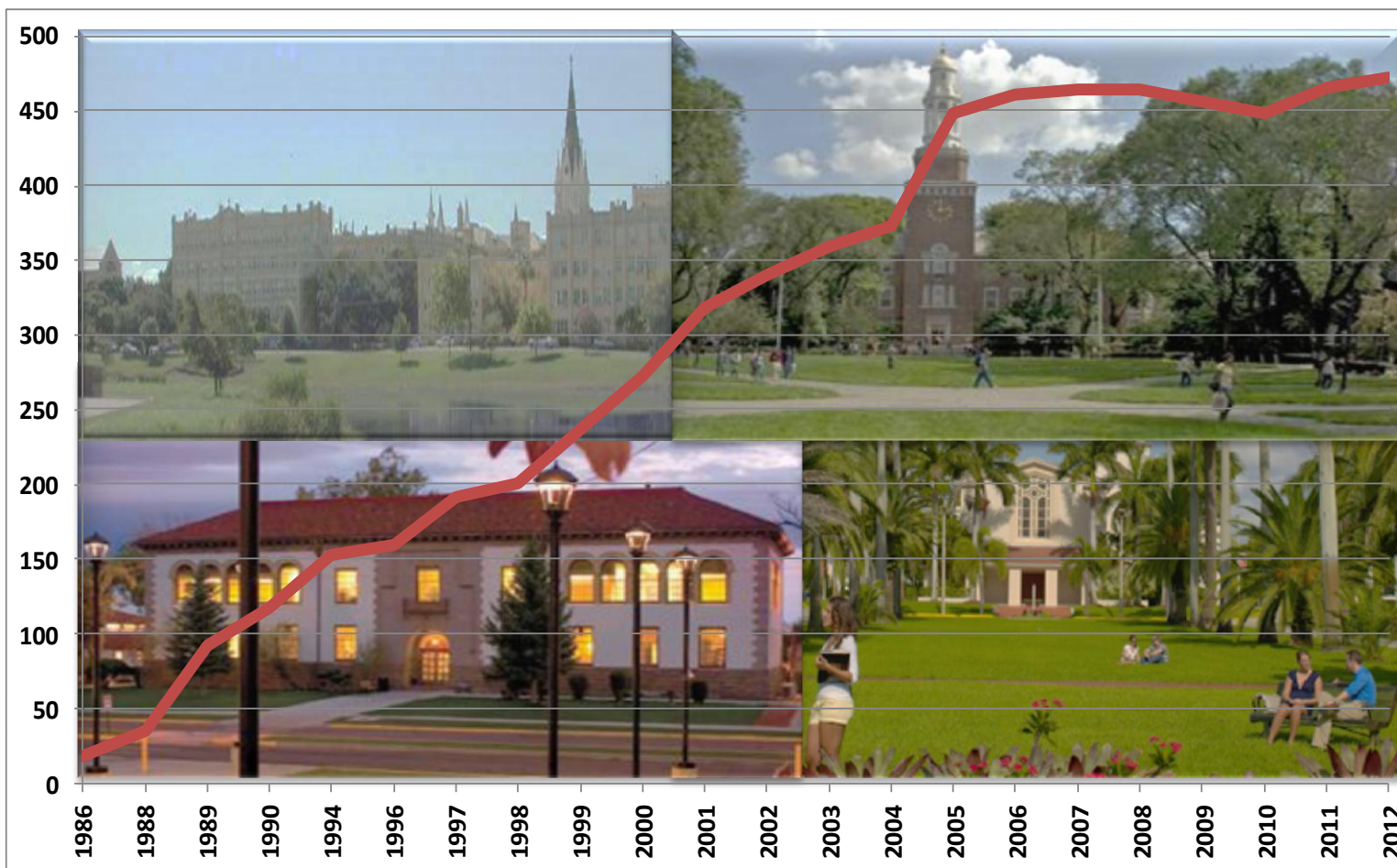

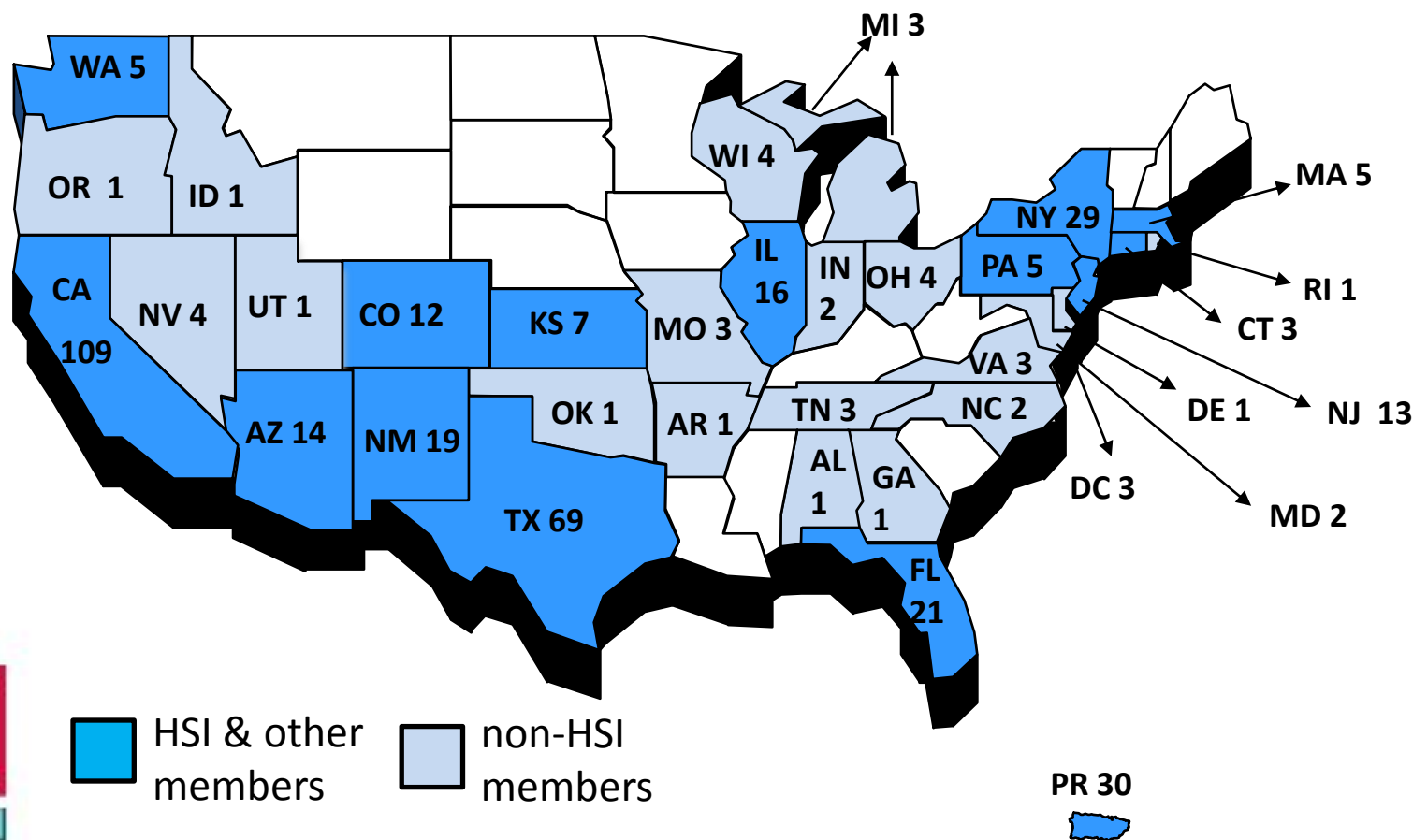

HACU Priorities
