- Faculty and Staff Affiliate members have exclusive access to a HACU Discussion Board that provides a forum to communicate with each other, discuss current educational issues, and exchange ideas on diversity.
- HACU hosts three major conferences which provide vital platforms for advocacy, information, collaboration, networking, and recognition. These include HACU's National Capitol Forum on Hispanic Higher Education (Washington, D.C.), the Annual Conference, and a Biennial International Conference. Faculty and Staff Affiliate members receive greater discounted member rates than any other attendee category to all HACU conferences and events.
- In conjunction with HACU's Annual Conference, the HACU Latina/o Higher Education Leadership Institute is offered as a pre-conference event to promote Latina/o leadership development at HSIs and higher education institutions. Through the Latina/o Leadership Institute, early, mid- and senior-level Latina/o higher education administrators and leaders collaborate and share their expertise. The institute creates an opportunity to explore and discuss leadership challenges and strategies for making higher education institutions more responsive to the educational needs of Latinos and other underrepresented groups.
- Faculty and Staff Affiliate members receive several publications on a regular basis including an electronic newsletter, *The Voice of Hispanic Higher Education* magazine, electronic member advisories, the HACU Membership Directory, and the Annual Report. All Faculty and Staff Affiliate members are listed in the Membership Directory, conference programs and other publications.
